- Class AA—750 or more students (Grades 9 to 12 inclusive)  
Class A —500 to 749 students (Grades 9 to 12 inclusive)  
Class B —250 to 499 students (Grades 9 to 12 inclusive)  
Class C —249 or less students (Grades 9 to 12 inclusive)  
Class D —Beginner Bands (Bands organized since the second semester of previous year.)  
Class E —Junior High Bands—Where so organized.

## RATINGS

Rating combinations of the three judges which will place a participant in the various divisions are:

- Division I—Superior—(1, 1, 1), (1, 1, 2), (1, 1, 3), (1, 1, 4).  
Division II—Excellent—(1, 2, 2), (1, 2, 3), (1, 2, 4), (2, 2, 2), (2, 2, 3), (2, 2, 4).  
Division III—Good—(1, 3, 3), (1, 3, 4), (2, 3, 3), (2, 3, 4), (3, 3, 3), (3, 3, 4).  
Division IV—Average—(1, 4, 4), (2, 4, 4), (3, 4, 4), (4, 4, 4).

Class AA, A, and B Bands may not receive a concert competition rating more than one division higher than its rating in sight reading.

The concert rating of Class C Bands that elect to sight read will not be affected by the sight reading rating.

No other group or director shall be present near the room where the sight reading competition is taking place.

The Choral sight reading rating will not affect the concert rating.

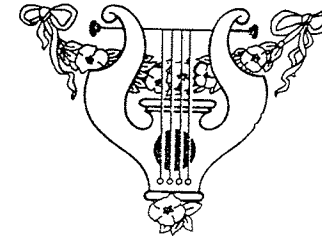
