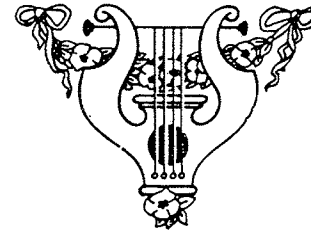

**PROCEDURE FOR CONTEST**

Contest will begin on Wednesday, April 12, 1967, at 8:00 a.m., running through Saturday, April 15, 1967.

Warm-up will be in Canterbury Chapel immediately preceding concert time.

Sight reading will be in the University Band room on the fourth floor of the Union Building, immediately following playing time.

Solo and Ensemble will be on the top floor of the Union Building.

Fees are 50c per student with a \$5.00 school registration fee.

DIV. I -- SUPERIOR (1-1-1) (1-1-2) (1-1-3) (1-1-4)

DIV. II -- EXCELLENT (1-2-2) (1-2-3) (1-2-4) (2-2-2) (2-2-3) (2-2-4)

DIV. III -- GOOD (1-3-3) (2-3-3) (1-3-4) (2-3-4) (3-3-3) (3-3-4)

In addition to the ratings of the three adjudicators, as listed above, Class AA, A, BB, B and C bands may not receive a rating more than one division higher than the rating given by the sight-reading adjudicator.
