## RATINGS

Ratings of High School bands will be on a point system as follows:

Superior Rating or First Division—5 points

Excellent Rating or Second Division—4 points

Good Rating or Third Division—3 points

Fair Rating or Fourth Division—2 points

Overall ratings will be decided on the following basis:

18 to 20 points—Superior or Division I

14 to 17 points—Excellent or Division II

10 to 13 points—Good or Division III

8 to 9 points—Fair or Division IV

All bands are required to sight-read at State Competition-Festival. Class E, EE and D bands will sight-read for criticism only and it will not affect their ratings. In addition to the ratings of the three adjudicators as listed above, Class AA, A, BB, B, CC and C bands may not receive a rating more than one division higher than their sight-reading score.
