RATINGS

Ratings of High School bands will be on a point system as follows:

Superior Rating or First Division 5 Points
Excellent Rating or Second Division 4 Points
Good Rating or Third Division 3 Points
Fair Rating or Fourth Division 2 Points

Overall ratings will be decided on the following basis:

18 - 20 Points Superior or Division I
14 - 17 Points Excellent or Division II
10 - 13 Points Good or Division III
8 - 9 Points Fair or Division IV

All bands are required to sight-read at State Competition Festival. Class F - E - EE - D band will sight-read for criticism only and it will not affect their ratings. In addition to the rating of the three adjudicators as listed above, Class C - CC - B - BB - A - AA bands may not receive a rating more than one division higher than their sight-reading score.
