RATINGS

Ratings for all bands will be on a point system as follows:

Superior Rating or First Division .....	5 points
Excellent Rating or Second Division .....	4 points
Good Rating or Third Division .....	3 points
Fair Rating or Fourth Division .....	2 points

The three concert ratings and the sight reading are totalled, and the overall rating is decided on the following basis:

18-20 points .....	Superior or Division I
14-17 points .....	Excellent or Division II
10-13 points .....	Good or Division III
8-9 points .....	Fair or Division IV

All bands are required to sightread at the State Competition Festival. Class F - E - EE - D bands may not receive an overall rating more than two (2) divisions higher than their sightreading score. Class C - CC - B - BB - A - AA bands may not receive an overall rating more than one (1) division higher than their sightreading score.
