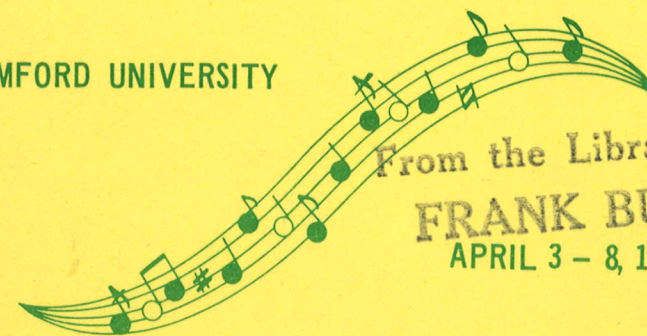

**RATINGS**

- Ratings for all bands will be on a point system as follows:
- Superior Rating or First Division . . . . . 5 points
  - Excellent Rating or Second Division . . . . . 4 points
  - Good Rating or Third Division . . . . . 3 points
  - Fair Rating or Fourth Division . . . . . 2 points

The three concert ratings and the sight reading are totalled, and the overall rating is decided on the following basis:

- 18-20 points . . . . . Superior or Division I
- 14-17 points . . . . . Excellent or Division II
- 10-13 points . . . . . Good or Division III
- 8- 9 points . . . . . Fair or Division IV

All Bands are required to sightread at the State Competition Festival. Class C-CC-B-BB-A-AA bands may not receive an overall rating more than one (1) division higher than their sightreading score.
