Superior Rating or First Division .....	5 points
Excellent Rating or Second Division .....	4 points
Good Rating or Third Division .....	3 points
Fair Rating or Fourth Division .....	2 points

The three concert ratings and the sight reading are totalled, and the overall rating is decided on the following basis:

18-20 points .....	Superior or Division I
14-17 points .....	Excellent or Division II
10-13 points .....	Good or Division III
8- 9 points .....	Fair or Division IV

**All Bands are required to sightread at the State Competition Festival. Class C-CC-B-BB-A-AA bands may not receive an overall rating more than one (1) division higher than their sightreading score.**
