Fair Rating or Fourth Division	2 points

The three concert ratings and the sight reading are totalled, and the overall rating is decided on the following basis:

18-20 points	Superior or Division I
14-17 points	Excellent or Division II
10-13 points	Good or Division III
8- 9 points	Fair or Division IV

ALL BANDS ARE REQUIRED TO SIGHTREAD AT THE STATE COMPETITION FESTIVAL.
CLASS C-CC-B-BB-A-AA BANDS MAY NOT RECEIVE AN OVERALL RATING MORE THAN ONE (1)
DIVISION HIGHER THAN THEIR SIGHTREADING SCORE.
