Fair Rating or Fourth Division	2 points

The three concert rating and the sight reading are totalled, and the overall rating is decided on the following basis:

18-20 points	Superior or Division I
14-17 points	Excellent or Division II
10-13 points.....	Good or Division III
8-9 points.....	Fair or Division IV

All Bands are required to sightread at the State Competition Festival. Class C-CC-B-BB-A-AA bands may not receive an overall rating more than one (1) division higher than their sightreading score.
